

Go by Spark - How to add the current date on the Feed Editor? Scribe[®]

The Feed Editor provides the ability for users to organized and make changes to the print program. After a print program is created, users can download it into PDF. The design and layout of the print program is pre-approved by the client.

1 Navigate to your GO Software URL and open the Itinerary Page.

2 Click on the "Newspaper Icon" to open the feed editor for the specific day.


3 Click the "+" green icon to add a content box.
