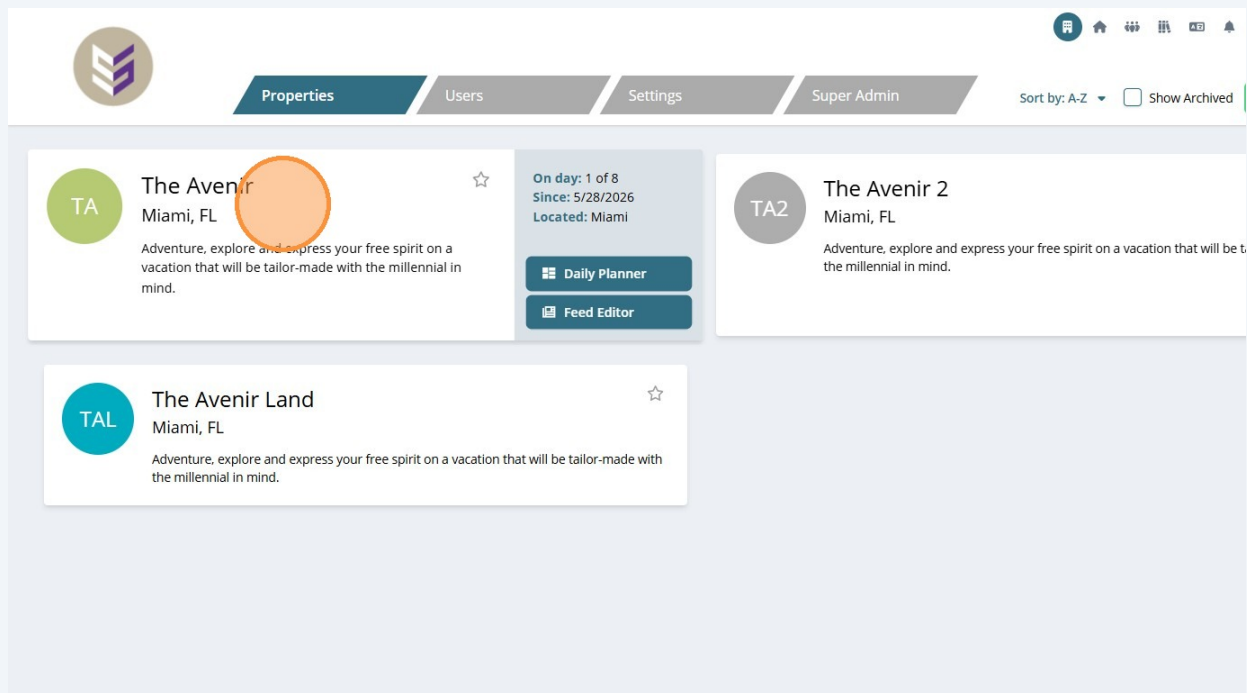


GO Mobile: How to add unique links under the hamburger menu icon?

In this guide, we will walk you through the process of adding unique links to GO Mobile.

From your **GO URL**, click on the property you'd like to add an unique link to GO Mobile.



2 Click on the **Settings** tab

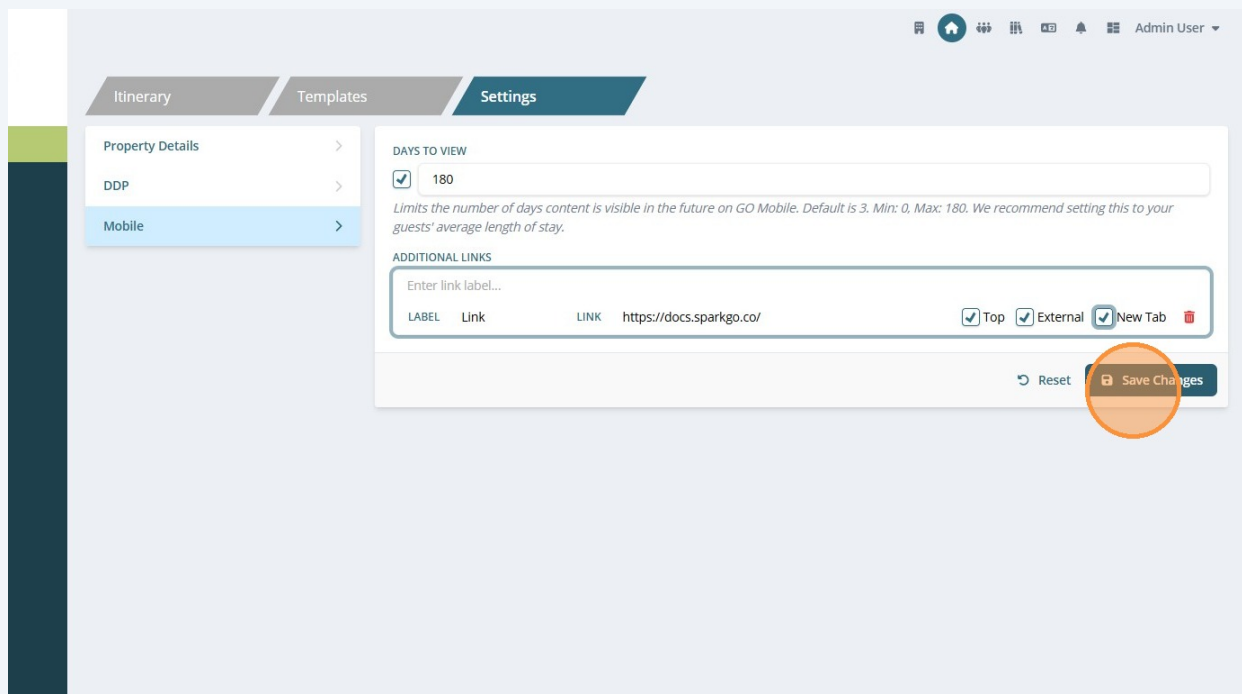
3 Click on **Mobile**, then select **Additional Link**.

Complete the following fields:

- **Label:** Enter a short, descriptive title that helps guests understand what they can expect when they click the link.
- **Link:** Enter the URL you would like guests to be directed to when they select the link.
- **Top** checkbox: Select it if you want the link to appear at the top of the list in GO Mobile.
- **External** checkbox: Select it if you want the link to open in a the same window.
- **New tab** checkbox: Select it if you want the link to open in a new browser tab.

The **Top** checkbox can be combined with either or both of the other two options.

Once you are finished, please remember to click **Save Changes**.
